NOTICE

Required miscellaneous items NOT included in the Package are as following; Immigration related expense (Special Study Permit, Visa Extension, NBI Clearance, English Proficiency, Travel expenses for exams, board and lodging, 2nd Class medical reveal and 1st Class Medical.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be 18 years old or above
2. Must hold a CAA Philippines CPL with Instrument Rating
3. Must have 200 hours total of flying time (Single Pilot A/C)
4. Must have a C-172 Rating
5. Must hold a Class I Medical Certificate
6. Must hold a valid radio license (NTC)
7. Must hold a valid English Language Proficiency Certificate (ELP)

REQUIREMENTS

1. Application Form
2. Photocopy of Passport or valid ID
3. Photocopy of all Certificates issued by previous school
4. Photocopy of Certificates and Licenses issued by CAAP
5. Photocopy of ELP
6. Photocopy of NTC
7. Photocopy of Birth Certificate
8. NBI Clearance
9. Transcript of Record (TOR) and Diploma for College Graduate Ten (10) 2 x 2 and Ten (10) 1 x 1 wearing pilot uniform with blue background

NOTICE

1. Training contents or hours may be revised due to the revision of CAAP regulations.
2. In case you cannot full fill the requirements or skill tests for any licenses and/or ratings within the training hours monitored above, you shall be required to fly additionally, for which you shall be charged separately on a per hour basis.
3. Miscellaneous charges like CAAP examination fee, etc. will be shouldered by CAFS initially . In case of retake of any exams, you shall bear the charges payable in Cash.
4. All students must be present 30 minutes before the departure time for flight training and 15 minutes before the start of Ground classes & Simulator Sessions. Cancellations of the flights/classes can only be done 24 hours prior to commencement. Late cancellations or no show will be penalized on a per hour basis.
5. Late payment of school fees are subject to 1% interest per month which will reflect on the invoice.
6. Training costs per hour includes Pre and Post flight briefing, Instructor fees, Take-off and Landing fees, Operational and Aeronautical charges, Insurance (Pilots, Passengers, Hull and Third party)
7. In the event that a student face challenges in completing the Private Pilot License (PPL) program within the designated 3 to 4 month timeframe, the school will allow a grace period of 2-months before fees become non-refundable.
