Required miscellaneous items NOT included in the Package are as following; Immigration related expense (Special Study Permit, Visa Extension, NBI Clearance, English Proficiency, Travel expenses for exams, board and lodging, 2nd Class medical reveal and 1st Class Medical.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must hold a CAA Philippines PPL (A) or CPL (A)
2. Must hold a Class II or I Medical Certificate
3. Must hold a valid radio license (NTC)
4. Must hold a valid English Language Proficiency Certificate (ELP)
5. Must have his/her Pilot Logbook stamped by previous Flight School / Flying Club

NOTICE

1. Training contents or hours may be revised due to the revision of CAAP regulations.
2. In case you cannot full fill the requirements or skill tests for any licenses and/or ratings within the training hours monitored above, you shall be required to fly additionally, for which you shall be charged separately on a per hour basis.
3. Miscellaneous charges like CAAP examination fee, etc. will be shouldered by CAFS initially . In case of retake of any exams, you shall bear the charges payable in Cash.
4. All students must be present 30 minutes before the departure time for flight training and 15 minutes before the start of Ground classes & Simulator Sessions. Cancellations of the flights/classes can only be done 24 hours prior to commencement. Late cancellations or no show will be penalized on a per hour basis.
5. Late payment of school fees are subject to 1% interest per month which will reflect on the invoice.
6. Training costs per hour includes Pre and Post flight briefing, Instructor fees, Take-off and Landing fees, Operational and Aeronautical charges, Insurance (Pilots, Passengers, Hull and Third party)
7. In the event that a student face challenges in completing the Private Pilot License (PPL) program within the designated 3 to 4 month timeframe, the school will allow a grace period of 2-months before fees become non-refundable.
